I just wanted to update you on several important arrangements and information as the staff prepare for the children returning.

Back to School

School Reopens on Monday 4th September.



After School Club

Due to a number of changes in staffing during the summer months, we are working hard to ensure our after-school club will be operating again from Monday 11th September at a cost of £2.50 per day. Due to a significant decrease in school funding, we now require parents to book their days the week before, not on the day, to give us time to prepare activities and staffing. If you have a booked your child in for a certain day and they are absent, we will be unable to refund you as staff will have already been assigned. Further information will be sent to parents next week to confirm that they club is starting on the 11th September.

Homework

Homework will begin for most classes on Monday 11th September. Homework is an important part of the learning process, however, we understand how busy homes can be.

We recommend the following times for homework completion and would ask that children do not spend much longer completing their set tasks:

- P1/2 children should spend around 15 minutes;
- P3 children should spend around 20 minutes;
- P4/5 children should spend around 30 minutes;
- P6/7 children should spend around 45 minutes.



School Holidays

Our school calendar is on the website. Please check the dates as there has been a slight amendment in Term 1. Parent/Teacher meetings are on Friday 27th October, therefore, school will be closed that day for pupils. After these meetings, the school will remain closed for a week-long Halloween break (30th October – 3rd November).
